The visit also allowed the students to learn about aspects of project management, health and safety and environmental issues.

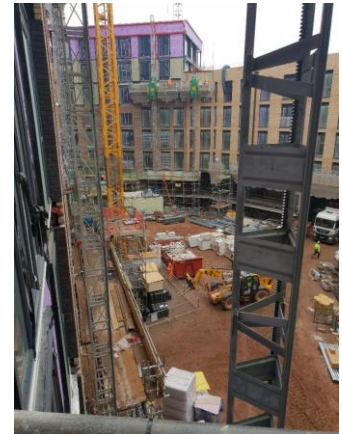
